Explanations for the sections marked with numbers overleaf:

 The grantor must provide details of its company registration or, in the absence of that, details of any other registration. The grantor may be a legal person, other organisation without legal personality or a private entrepreneur. In order to prove the authority of the person granting authorisation to represent an organisation on behalf of that organisation, a specimen signature must be appended in accordance with paragraph 8) of point 4.2.2 of these GTC. Organisations which do not have a company registration or other registration number must provide

Organisations which do not have a company registration or other registration number must provide Magyar Posta with any other official document in proof of the existence of the organisation in the original or drawn up as a public document or in the form of a simple copy.

- 2) The authorised person must provide the details that appear in his or her official identity document.
- 3) If the grantor is an organisation which is not a legal person and as such does not have a representative authorised to act and sign on behalf of the organisation, the simultaneous involvement of two witnesses, giving their signature, and their legible name and permanent address (or, in the lack of that, their temporary place of residence), is required for the authorisation to enter into force.
